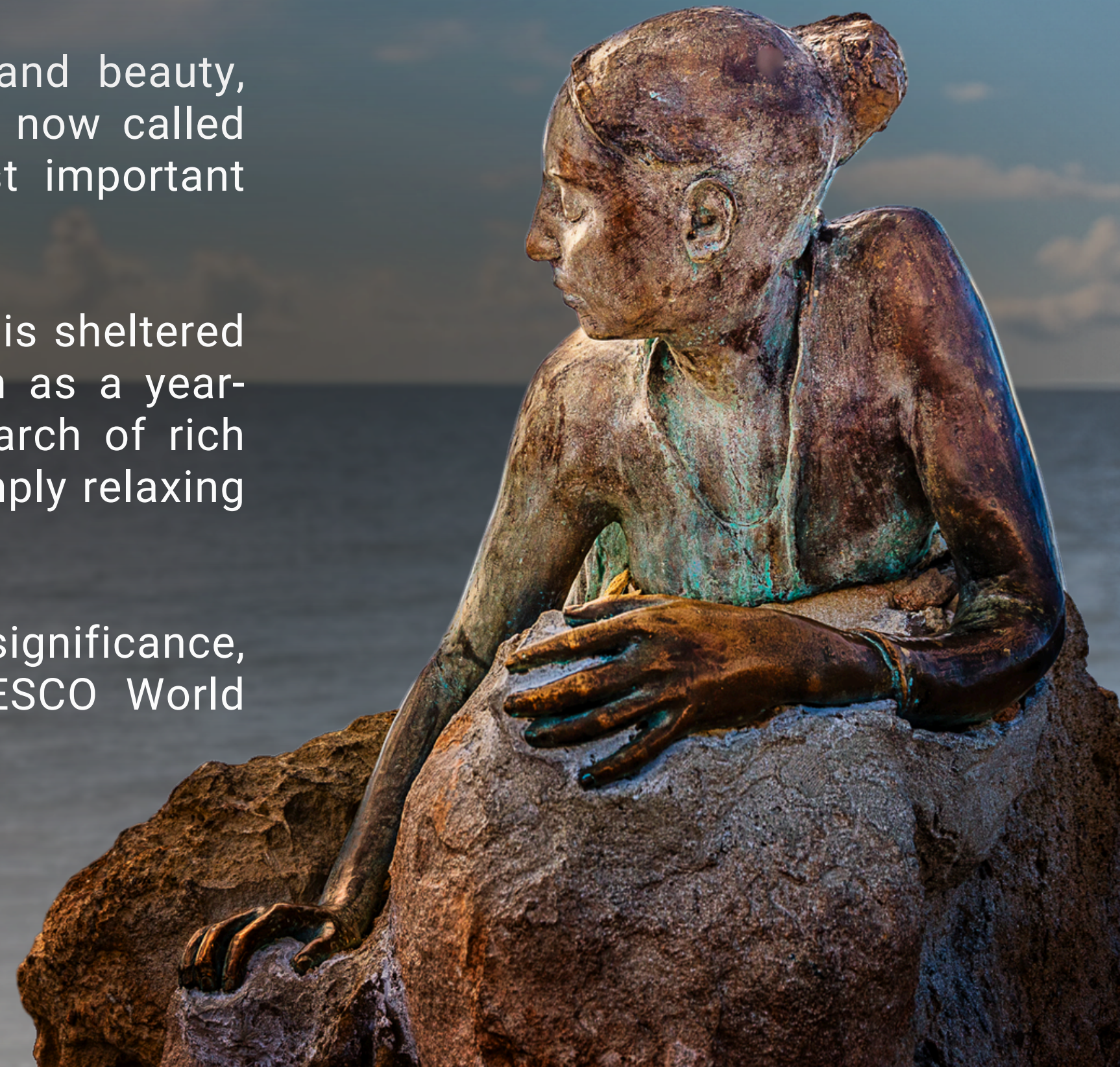


A CITY WOVEN IN MYTH AND HERITAGE

As the Greeks believed, Aphrodite, the goddess of love and beauty, emerged from the coast of Paphos, near a rock formation now called “Petra tou Romiou”; the old city became one of her most important worship centres.

Paphos is located on the southwestern coast of Cyprus and is sheltered from the north by the majestic Troodos Mountains. Known as a year-round destination, catering the needs of vacationers in search of rich cultural and gastronomic experiences, local traditions, or simply relaxing moments by the beach.

Its rich history, ancient architecture, mosaics, and religious significance, gave Paphos the opportunity to earn a spot on the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1980

AIRPORT TRANSFERS | PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Larnaca Airport to Venue

Currently, there is no direct bus service from Larnaca Airport to Paphos.

However, you may follow the next steps:

Step 1: From Larnaca Airport use the **Limassol Airport Express** coaches in order to reach Limassol city (bus stop “**Saint George Havouzas**”). To see the route click [here](#).

Step 2: Use the **Intercity Buses** (green buses) from “Saint Georgios Chavouzas Church” station in Limassol to reach Paphos city (bus stop “Pervola - Karavella”). To see the route click [here](#).

Step 3: From “Karavella” station, use the **Paphos Bus Service** line **607** to reach “Agiou Georgiou Ave. - Kolpou Korallion Ave” bus stop. From there, use the bus line **615** to reach “Coral Bay” bus stop. To see the routes click [here](#).

AIRPORT TRANSFERS | PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Paphos Airport to Venue

Step 1: Use the public **bus line 612** from Paphos Airport to reach Tombs of the Kings Bus Station.
